WATERING

Due to the windy and dry summer season in the Western Cape, irrigation is a crucial factor for successful tree establishment.

The following watering schedule is recommended for all trees;


- 1st year 80 liter per week
- 2nd year 80 liter every second week
- 3rd year 80 liter every third week
- 4th + depending on requirements of sites/ species

Applications might vary according to local climate/soil conditions. Irrigate at the discretion of the Area Manager.
